NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that a Special Election of the Wheatland Scottsville Joint Fire District will take place at the annual election of the Wheatland Scottsville Joint Fire District on Tuesday, December 13, 2022, held at the Wheatland Scottsville Joint Fire Station, 385 Scottsville-Mumford Road, Scottsville, New York 14546 on December 13, 2022, between the hours of 6:00 p.m. and 9:00 p.m. for the purpose of voting on the following proposition:

## RESOLUTION

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE WHEATLAND SCOTTSVILLE JOINT FIRE DISTRICT TO EXPEND IN FISCAL YEARS 2022, 2023 AND ANNUALLY THEREAFTER, THE MAXIMUM AMOUNT OF \$ 150,000.00 IN EXCESS OF THE AMOUNT AUTHORIZED BY TOWN LAW \$176(18) TO BE EXPENDED ANNUALLY BY THE WHEATLAND SCOTTSVILLE JOINT FIRE DISTRICT

**BE IT RESOLVED,** by the Board of Commissioners of the Wheatland Scottsville Joint Fire District, Town of Wheatland, Monroe County, New York, as follows:

<u>Section 1.</u> This resolution authorizes the Wheatland Scottsville Joint Fire District to expend annually, for fiscal years 2022, 2023 and subsequent years thereafter the amount of \$ 150,000.00 in excess of the Wheatland Scottsville Joint Fire District statutory spending limitation established according to \$ 176(18) of the Town Law.

<u>Section 2.</u> The Wheatland Scottsville Joint Fire District will be authorized to expend in the budget years, 2022, 2023, and subsequent years, \$ 150,000.00 in excess of the statutory spending limitation established for fire districts by the Town Law for that particular budget year.

<u>Section 3.</u> The Wheatland Scottsville Joint Fire District, to carry out its statutory responsibilities, that expenditures in excess of the spending limitation established by law need to be exceeded, due in part by the payment of sums necessary to lease real and personal property owned by the Village of Scottsville.

<u>Section 4.</u> Subject to the applicable provisions of Town Law, the authorization to expend sums in excess of the statutory spending limitation in any one fiscal year or to expend such sums annually thereafter may be accomplished only after such a proposition authorizing the expenditure has been approved by the voters of the Wheatland Scottsville Joint Fire District at either the annual or a special election of the Wheatland Scottsville Joint Fire District.

<u>Section 5.</u> Any sums authorized to be expended in excess of the statutory spending limitation shall be raised by tax and will be spent only during the fiscal year in which such tax is to be levied.

Section 6. Should this proposition be approved by the voters of the Wheatland Scottsville Joint Fire District, the amount of \$ 150,000.00 may be expended annually in excess of the amount authorized by the statutory spending limitation which is set forth in \$176(18) of the Town Law, for budget years 2022, 2023 and annually thereafter and this authorization shall continue and the amount may be continued to be spent annually and shall continue in effect until changed by vote at an annual or special election of the Wheatland Scottsville Joint Fire district.

<u>Section 7.</u> This Resolution shall be published once in full in the official newspaper of the Wheatland Scottsville Joint Fire District and posted pursuant to Town Law.

<u>Section 8.</u> This Resolution is subject to a Mandatory Referendum, and shall, before becoming effective, be approved at a Special Election of the qualified electors of the Wheatland Scottsville Joint Fire District to be held at the Wheatland Scottsville Joint Fire Station, 385 Scottsville-Mumford Road, Scottsville, New York 14546 on December 13, 2022, between the hours of 6:00 p.m. and 9:00 p.m. The

District Secretary or the Deputy Secretary is hereby authorized and directed to prepare ballots in substantially the following form:

SHALL

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE WHEATLAND SCOTTSVILLE JOINT FIRE DISTRICT TO EXPEND IN FISCAL YEARS 2022, 2023 AND ANNUALLY THEREAFTER, THE MAXIMUM AMOUNT OF \$ 150,000.00 IN EXCESS OF THE AMOUNT AUTHORIZED BY TOWN LAW \$176(18) TO BE EXPENDED ANNUALLY BY THE WHEATLAND SCOTTSVILLE JOINT FIRE DISTRICT
